

SCGC COMPETITION STRUCTURE 2011

As we move into the New Year, we are going to make some positive additions to the competition formats. These are intended to give members more to play for and create more opportunities to win prizes.

CHAMPIONS TROPHY – SUNDAY 24TH APRIL

Winners of both Medal and Stableford Competitions between April 2010 and March 2011 will be entered into the Champions Trophy event on the above date. This will decide the 2010/11 Champion of Champions. The event will be an 18 hole medal format competition and all players will be drawn and allocated tee times starting from 7.30am. The draw will take place after the March 2011 Stableford. If you are aware that you have previously won a monthly competition, then please keep this date free. Prizes will be awarded for the Top 3 places.

ORDER OF MERIT

Starting from the January 2011 Medal, and running throughout the year, all competitions will offer the opportunity to win Order of Merit points. The top ten finishes in each division will be allocated points according to their position. The table opposite shows the scoring system. At the end of every month, a table that combines all divisions will be published to show the overall positions, which will also be uploaded to the website. At the end of the year, the top three places overall, across all 3 divisions, will win prizes. 1st prize is £50, 2nd £30 and 3rd £20, and there will also be trophies presented. This will not cost any extra money to enter, so the more competitions you play, the more points you can score against your Order of Merit standing. The standings for the first 3 months will be produced at the start of April 2011.

SUMMER ECLECTIC

An Eclectic is a separate competition, played alongside the standard competitions, which selects the best score at each hole over a number of rounds of golf, giving a final best 18 hole score at the end for each player.

Every Medal and Stableford between April and September 2011 will be an Eclectic qualifier and any cards entered will automatically

count towards your Eclectic score. At the end of September, prizes will be awarded to the Winner and Runner Up of both the Gross and Nett Eclectic competition. The winners will receive £30 each and the runners up £15 each. A monthly score sheet will be published at the end of the month on both the notice board and website.

PRIZE MONEY

All competition prize money will continue to be credited to your Loyalty Card.

COMPETITION SIGN IN, SCORE ENTRY AND NON-RETURNS

Starting from the March 2011 Medal, an entry list will be created on the system matched to the Competition Entry Book that is signed before your round. If no score is entered for a golfer that has entered the competition, it will count as a non-return, and this will mean an automatic handicap increase of 0.1. It is therefore important that all cards are entered into the touch screen on completion of your round, and the cards placed into the box as normal.

Entries to a competition are only valid if;

- a) You have entered your name in the Competition Book
- b) You enter your score via the Touch Screen.
- c) Your scorecard is placed into the Competition Box.

Any entries that do not meet this criteria will count as non-returns and also be subject to an automatic handicap increase of 0.1.
